**POSITIVELY TWISTED** is a game that refers to the transactional analysis theory. The creator of the theory of effective communication between people, Eric Berne, stated that one of the most basic human needs is the need for social transactions. The term of social transactions can be understood as any kind of signal displayed by a person, which informs others that they are in a line of sight of that person (look, smile, handshake, words etc.) Those signs are essential for proper development and interaction.

The game encourages employees to strengthen and reinforcing behaviours which facilitate motivation, create a positive workplace atmosphere, and build mutual respect and an open attitude between people.
